

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
Removal: Keep all components removed from machine.






Installation: Do not tighten hardware completely unless noted.


- Install new Axle.
- Set Adjustment Bearing position and install Trailing Arm (A) or (B) to Frame with stock hardware.



Installation continued:

- Reinstall Sway Bar to Trailing Arm with hardware shown.
- Reinstall Shock to Trailing Arm with stock hardware.
- Repeat steps for opposite side.
- Reinstall Rotors, Calipers, and Hubs.
- SEE FOLLOWING PAGE: Reroute Passenger Side Brake Line. Install Brakeline Clips (D) to Brake Line and secure to Trailing Arm (A) with hardware shown.






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Installation continued:

- Install CV Guard Clips (E) to Trailing Arms (A)(B) with hardware shown.
- Install CV Guard Brackets (C) to Trailing Arms (A)(B) with hardware shown.
- Install stock CV Guards as shown.
