
## Parts Included with the PERRIN Lightweight Water Pump Pulley:

• (1) PERRIN Water Pump Pulley




# **Removal Instructions:**

- 1. Remove engine cover from engine bay by removing (2) plastic connectors at the rear and lifting up on the front of it. NOTE: Take time lifting up on the front of the cover as the OEM plastic nipples can easily break off of cover. This step is not necessary, but it makes reinstalling the serpentine belt much easier if it comes off of the other pulleys.
- 2. Locate and loosen (3) M6 bolts securing OEM water pump pulley to engine. NOTE: Do not remove the bolts, just loosen them!




- 3. Install a 14mm wrench onto the automatic belt tensioner and rotate enough to remove serpentine belt from water pump pulley.
- 4. Remove all (3) bolts and water pump pulley from engine.



### Installation

- 1. Install PERRIN water pump pulley over water pump and secure with M6 bolts removed earlier. Tighten bolts hand tight.
- 2. Reinstall serpentine belt onto pulleys except center pulley (pulley with auto tensioner on it). Using 14mm wrench, rotate tensioner enough to slide belt over pulley and relieve tension on automatic tensioner and slip belt over pulley.
- 3. Tighten (3) 10mm bolts on water pump pulley to 10.3ft-lbs of torque.

- 4. Start engine and make sure belt is riding completely on all pulleys, and check that all pulleys are running true and not wobbling.
- 5. If no problems are found, take car for test drive, then recheck bolts on water pump pulley for being tight.
