

SMK340 INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS – 4th Gen F-Body


FRONT TOOLS REQUIRED:

- Hydraulic jack and jack stands
- Metric Wrenches and Sockets

INSTALLATION:

- 1. Lift the front of the vehicle and safely support with jack stands under the cradle.
- 2. Using a **10mm** and **13mm socket**, remove the three (3) bolts holding the sway bar bracket deflector shield to the chassis and the sway bar bolt.
- 3. Using a **13mm socket**, remove the bolts holding the front sway bar to the sway bar bracket, allow the sway bar to hang.

 NOTE: It is not necessary to fully remove the sway bar.
- 4. Using a **13mm socket**, remove each sway bar mounting bracket from the chassis.
- 5. Install your new sway bar mounting bracket to the chassis. Start all bolts before tightening them to **40ft-lbs**.
- Re-install the sway bar, torque fasteners to 40ft-lbs. The bolt with the studded head goes on the driver side front.
- 7. On the driver side, route the traction control cable on the outside of the bracket as shown. Replace the deflector shield.
- 8. Lower vehicle.
