BEFORE YOU BEGIN

Always park your vehicle in a safe and level location and allow plenty of time for the engine bay and exhaust to completely cool. Locate and prepare your work space with each required tool listed above. Unbox all components and verify the contents and quantities before you begin. This install guide has been photographed and written on a 2019 Golf R. Some steps and factory hardware specifications may vary depending on vehicle model, year, and region. This guide is for refrence purposes only. If you are unsure of the installation procedure for any individual step or part, please seek professional help before proceeding. While this guide was shot on a MK7.5 R, the instructions will remain roughly the same for a MK7 or 8V S3

02 - 4x 66MM Band Clamp for Exh Tips

03 - Lap Joint Exhaust Band Clamp 65mm x 63.5mm M5 x 0.80 mm Thread, 10mm Long

04 - 4x 2.5" Single Wall Exhaust Tip


05 - MK7/7.5 R & 8V S3 Resonator Section

06 - Lap Joint Exhaust Band Clamp 76.2mm x 73.2mm

07 - MK7.5 R Rear Muffler


08 - 3" TO OE 65MM SLIP FIT ADAPTER


10 - 4x Button Head Hex Drive Screw, Passivated 18-8 Stainless Steel,










Remove the four 13mm nuts then remove the exhaust cross member.









Pull the exhaust valve wiring retainer straight down to remove it from the body of the car.




Pictured you will see one of the the exhaust valve harnesses. They are located on top side of each muffler section of the exhaust. To remove each plug. You pull out the gray tab and then depress it while pulling the harness away from the plug.






Remove the front exhaust hanger by using a 13mm socket.






Pull the exhuast from the middle hanger to completely detatch it from the vehicle. Sometimes some lubrication can help aid if it's being stubborn.



Lubrication and/or an exhaust hager removal tool can greatly aid removal/reinstallation of the hangers.







If you are installing your IE Catback on an OEM Exhaust, you'll layout and install this reducer and clamps. If you're installing onto an IE Catback, you will use the supplied clamp and not a reducer.




From here forward, when installing, all the clamps will be very loosly installed to allow adjustment at the end. So don't clamp them down until instructed.














Slide the supplied clamp onto the front of your IE Muffler section.




Raise the muffler section into place and have another pair of hands hold it roughly in place while the two hangers are secured with the OE 13mm Bolts. If you'd like your muffler/tips to have a bit more space from the valence, you can install the provided shims/washers between the body and the hangers on this step.

Once everything is aligned, tighten the clamps starting from the front of the vehicle then work your way back towards the rear. This will be done with a 14mm socket and you may need a 15mm box end wrench to hold the nut in place while tightening. When tightening down, we recommend using an alternating method to ensure that you get even crushing of the clamps.





Install your IE Catback Tips and adjust the distance in which they stick out to your liking. Once they're in place, tighten the 14mm clamps. If you'd like, you can also install the clamps on the top side as well.




Once everything is aligned and you have adjusted tip protrusion, ensure all clamps are tightened to 40 ft/lb's. You can now reinstall the cross member support and enjoy the look and sound of your new IE Performance Catback Exhaust!
