- 01 3" (76.2mm) OEM Style Exhaust Butt Clamp
- 02 MK8/8Y AWD Cat Section
- 03 MQB DOWNPIPE BOLT-ON BRACKET
- 04 MK8/8Y FWD Mid Pipe
- 05 Exhaust Reducer Kit w/Clamps, 76mm x 65mm
- 06 TYPE 18-8 STAINLESS STEEL FLAT WASHER
- 07 18-8 STAINLESS STEEL HEX HEAD CAP SCREW
- 08 18-8 Stainless Steel Serrated Flange Locknut, M10 x 1.5 mm




Some items may be partially assembled.





Begin by allowing your engine bay to cool completely.

Once it's cooled down, use an o2 Sensor wrench to remove the top o2 Sensor from the OE Cat.




Release v band connector using a 6mm Allen





Remove four 13mm to remove the cross bar



Loosen exhaust clamps to disconnect dp from catback using 13mm driver. The pictured car has an aftermarket catback so yours may look different.




Remove two 13mm bolts on cross brace




Remove 13mm engine block bolt






Remove two pass axle heat shield bolts using 8mm Allen. They are hard to picture, but they are next to the base of the axel.



Remove lower o2 sensor.





Loosen four 18mm & four 16mm bolts to lower subframe to give enough clearance for dp to come out.

Using an extra set of hands and possibly a pry bar, remove stock dp.






Slide top section of iE downpipe into place.









Tighten all subframe bolts back into place.

Remove stock dp mount from your OE Downpipe.

Install included dp mount onto ie dp using included nut washer and bolt using 15mm for nut 17mm for bolt

Press ie mount into stock mount then Install stock mount using 2 17mm bolts previously removed.

Install clamps on midpipe and install between dp and catback.





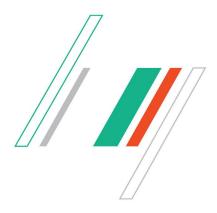
Reinstall crossbar, Vband clamp, and axle shield in reverse order. Once that is done, installation is complete!
