Some items may be partially assembled.





Park your car on level surface and apply the parking brake. It is also recommended to allow the car to cool before beginning this install procedure.

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Remove the four push clips from the radiator cowel. Use a small flathead to depress the center pin of the clip, then pull to remove entire clip.





Carefully pull up on the edges of the cowel to release it, remove it from the vehicle and set aside.

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
Remove the two bolts from the intake snorkel using a T25 torx driver.





Disconnect the metal retaining clips and separate the inlet pipe from the airbox.

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Pull back on the airbox to disconnect it from the fender bracket, then pull up to disconnect the box from the lower grommets. Do not completely remove the airbox in this step. You will then remove the side fender bracket with a T30 torx driver.





Carefully pull the airbox up and disconnect the SAI (secondary air injection) hose from the underside of the airbox. Remove the airbox completely.

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
Remove the factory rubber grommets from the stock airbox, set them aside for reinstall. Note: If you do not see these grommets on the airbox, they may be in the frame rail.





Pull up on the hose clip to release the fuel line from the intake pipe, safely set fuel line outside the clip.


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Carefully pull to release the EVAP line from the rear of the intake pipe.




Disconnect the vacuum line from the intake pipe by carefully pulling it off the barb fitting.



Using a flat head screwdriver, loosen the hose clamp and remove the stock intake pipe from the vehicle.





Now is the time when if you have purchased the optional IE Throttle Body Upgrade, you can install it. Refer to the IEINCG3A product page at Performancebyie.com for install instructions.



Install the mounting bracket with T30 socket and then install the rubber isolator into the bracket. Silicone can help aid the install







Install longer mounting tab onto the upper location also using a 4mm socket




Install vacuum barb into vacuum hose located behind the throttle body.

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
Loosely install silicone hose to the manifold and plug the vacuum barb into place.





Loosely install aluminum pipe into silicone hose.

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Loosely install the silicone coupler onto intake






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
Press the intake down into the three rubber isolators. The bottom two will have to be done with feel since they aren't very visible.








Reinstall OEM Snorkle onto the radiator support.



Ensure all clamps, and bolts are tightened properly. You can then reinstall all OE hardware in reverse order.

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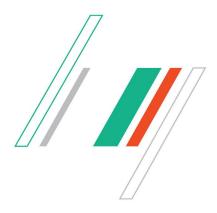
