


Some items may be partially assembled.





IE Reccomends dropping or allowing the Exhaust to move to gain better access in removing the sway bar. We shot this install guide with it removed for better access to photos.




Remove two 10mm Bolts the fasten the control arm cover. Repeat on other side.

There are two press fit retainers that fasten the control arm cover that need to be removed "Blind". Refer to the photo below for a better idea as to their location.




This view is to illustrate where the press fittings are located.


Remove the lower 13mm end link nut.






Remove 16mm End Link Nuts that connect the end links to the OE Sway Bar.

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Remove two #10 Tripple Square Bolts from the Sway Bar Mounting Bracket.






Remove OE Sway Bar from the vehicle. You may need to insert a flat head screwdriver into the control arm to pry out the OE End Links.




Use a Flathead Screwdriver to remove the OE Mounting Brackets from the bushing and set aside to be reinstalled later.





Grease the supplied IE Bushings useing the supplied grease. Spread evenly inside the bushing.



Install the new bushings onto the IE Sway Bar.



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Now is a great time to upgrade your Sway Bar End Links and get the most out of your new Sway Bar. Pictured are the IESUCI2 IE Rear Sway Bar End Links.

Roughly align and insert end links into the Sway Bar. This bar is adjustable. The hole that the link is currently inserted in will provide you with a softer feel compared to the lower.



Align and reinstall lower end link bolt and nut, along with the upper end link nut. Torque the upper nut to 55 ft lbs.


At this point it is reverse install from disassembly. Ensure all nuts and bolts are tight, all covers are reinstalled and the exhaust system is rehung.
