- Inspect panels visually on a regular basis. Dirt and foreign matter should be washed out to minimise build-up around hot components. 



FITTING PROCEDURE



- Using a 12mm Socket, remove the eight M8
 Bolts shown and the two OEM under vehicle
 protection panels.
- 2. The OEM panels and M8 bolts may be discarded.




3. Take note of the cross section of the M8 flange bolt and nut plate assembly.

The nut plate sits flat inside the front crossmember (shown in step 4), with the bolt entering from the bottom, through the Front UVP panel.



4. Insert a nut plate into each side of the front crossmember and align with the outer most holes on the crossmember.



5. Fit the Front UVP panel with six M8 flange bolts into threads in the chassis and the two M8 nut plates from step 4.

Only tighten to finger tight at this stage.


HINT: Consider using a lifting aid such as a transmission jack or seek assistance from a second person to help install the panels.
Alternatively, loosely fit the two M8 bolts diagonally, to help take the weight of the panel.


FITTING PROCEDURE



If fitting an ARB Bull bar, the stone panel is not required, skip to step 8.

Before tightening other bolts, slide the stone panel (highlighted) between the crossmember and the Front UVP panel in the direction of the arrow using the open-ended slots.







7. Use two M8 flange bolts to attach the panel to the crash beam, securing the front bumper.

> Align the stone panel so that the front face of the UVP panel is in line with the parallel face of the stone panel.

HINT: Keep all bolts loose until the panel is fitted and aligned.



Install the Differential Panel using four M8 Flange bolts into the four threads in the chassis from the OEM Panel.




All bolts can now be tightened and torqued to specification.



M8 - **22 Nm – 16lbft**.
