




Rock Slider Instructions

*(see drilling instructions) *Drill at (A) locations, in center of "T" connection in tube chassis frame. Referencing stock bolts in (B) locations. using a straight edge, mark and *drill mounting holes. Align with center 2x mounting holes in rock slider, use as a guide to mark and *drill the remaining holes. Ensure each mounting hole is drilled in to the center of the "Round" chassis tube frame. Install: (8x) ¼"-20 x 1¼" Self Tapping Bolts with Counter Sunk Washers in Rock sliders

{ if reference holes are not present. center rock slider for best fit, mark and drill, and install if alignment is off, it may cause minor complications with future skid plate install.}



Ensure each mounting hole is drilled in to the center of the "Round" chassis tubing.



*Drilling Instructions

Use a : #**N**º7 (13/64^{th"}) drill bit,

(One size above the commonly available $3/16^{th''}$ bit) Recommended $\frac{1}{4}$ " - 20 Tap *(Optional) To drill and thread self tapping bolts in to chassis frame.

Finger Thread All Bolts Prior To Fastening Securely With Power Tools.

We strongly recommend the use of a "Thread Locking Compound" Ensure all Bolts are fastened securely when complete.
