Due to the production variances and differing conditions of the frame, door adjustments may be necessary to avoid rubbing and proper fit Ensure proper fit before tightening hardware and continuing with installation! If adjustment is necessary, confirm all mounting points are secured


NOTE: Drill, 1/2" drill bit, & 1/4" drill bit needed for install.

<u>Installation Instructions:</u>

1. Make sure stock door opens and closes smoothly before proceeding. Then, place rubber strips on front door as shown.



- 2. Remove the two upper T40 torx bolts, and the two T25 torx screws from the stock door. Slide the front stealth door skin over the front of the stock door, lining up the mounting holes as shown. Then pull the stealth door skin over the rear of the stock door and line up the slots as shown.
- 3. Reinstall the two T25 torx screws and hand tighten.




- 4. Reinstall the upper two T40 torx bolts and hand tighten. Adjust the door along slots to make ensure smooth latch operation. It may be necessary to loosen the lower two T40 torx bolts to do so. Once the door is adjusted properly, torque down any loosened T40 torx bolts. Do not forget to fully tighten the two T25 torx screws as well.
- 5. Locate the lower mounting hole on the stealth door skin. You will need to drill a hole through the stock door plastic using a drill and 1/4" drill bit at this location. Once this is done, secure the door to the plastic using the provided M6 bolt, washer, and acorn nut.







6. Finally, using a drill and 1/2" drill bit, drill a hole into the front lower corner of the door area on the plastic. Once this is done, insert the provided push-in bumper. This concludes the front door install.





- 8. Remove the upper two T40 torx bolts and the T25 torx screw from the stock door. Slide the rear stealth door skin over the front of the stock door first, lining up the mounting hole. Then, pull the rear of the stealth door skin over the rear of the stock door and line up the slots.
- 9. Reinstall and hand tighten the T25 torx screw.
- 10. Reinstall the upper two T40 torx bolts and hand tighten. Adjust the door along slots to make ensure smooth latch operation. It may be necessary to loosen the lower two T40 torx bolts to do so. Once the door is adjusted properly, torque down any loosened T40 torx bolts. Do not forget to fully tighten the T25 torx screw as well.





11. Locate the rear lower mounting hole on the stealth door skin. You will need to drill a hole through the stock door plastic using a drill and 1/4" drill bit at this location. Once this is done, secure the door to the plastic using the provided M6 bolt, washer, and acorn nut. Repeat this for the front lower mounting hole. This concludes the rear door install.





12. Loosely install half clamps to the quarter panel using the provided M6 bolts. Line the quarter panel with the door frame, making sure the edges of the quarter panel run along the center lines of the tube. Tighten down hardware. This concludes the quarter panel install.





13. Finally, make sure all hardware and parts are properly fastened before operating vehicle. Installation is now complete.
