


2021 BRONCO ACC SENSOR RFI OCATION KIT




VERIFY YOU HAVE ALL THE COMPONENTS BEFORE STARTING THE INSTALLATION. REFER TO THE ENGINEERING DRAWINGS AT THE END OF THIS DOCUMENT FOR A COMPLETE PARTS LIST

Special Note

Be sure to remove your ACC Sensor before installing your LOD front bumper. If you currently have an LOD front bumper, you will need to remove it to complete this installation. This sensor relocation kit is designed to **ONLY** work with the **LOD Black Ops Front Bumper**.

After you have removed the Bronco front bumper, you will see the ACC Sensor (Automatic Cruise Control) mounted on the louver assembly.

Start by removing the 3 screws that mount the ACC Sensor and bracket to the louver assembly.



Next you will remove the entire louver assembly shown here. There are 4 screws that hold this assembly in place.



Remove the wire harness from the back side of the louver assembly.



You will need to lengthen the segment that connects to the back of the ACC Sensor. To do this, carefully unwrap the tape on the wire harness about 6 inches as shown here.



Finish by retaping the wire harness with new electrical tape or wire sheath of your choice.



Reinstall the wire harness back into the louver assembly as shown here. Leave the lengthened segment of wire harness hanging down.



Reinstall the louver assembly back into the Bronco frame. Remove the rubber shroud from the louver assembly. This will allow more room for your winch and also allow more air flow through to the cooler.



Remove the sensor from the stock metal mounting bracket. Use a small pry tool to unsnap the 3 posts.

Install the sensor into the new LOD Acc Sensor Mounting Brackets as shown here.




At this time you will need to complete the installation of your LOD front bumper.

Once your bumper is installed, proceed by installing your ACC Sensor and mounting bracket to the bottom side of your bumper as shown here.

Install the sensor and bracket into the rear most mounting holes and lined up with the back of the bumper winch plate.




Adjust your sensor bracket so it is perpendicular to the bumper and and raised up as high as it will go.



The isntallation of the ACC Sensor is now complete. We recommend you test drive your Bronco and test the ACC before installing the front bumper skid plate.


If the ACC Sensor does not function correctly you may need to adjust the tilt of the sensor or lower the sensor slightly.











ACC PIVOT BRACKET
