OILING INSTRUCTIONS K&N® Airforce Pre-Cleaner

This K&N Airforce Pre-Cleaner must be oiled before using. Use K&N[®] Recharger[®] kit 99-5000 or 99-5050.

INSTRUCTIONS:

OILING:

- 1. Saturate the K&N[®] Airforce Pre-Cleaner with K&N[®] filter oil.
- 2. Massage until it is fully covered.
- 3. Squeeze, do not wring the excess oil from the K&N Airforce Pre-Cleaner.
- 4. Install the K&N Airforce Pre-Cleaner on the K&N[®] air filter per the installation instructions.

CLEANING:

- 1. Remove the K&N Airforce Pre-Cleaner from the K&N air filter.
- Spray K&N air filter cleaner until it completely saturates the pre-cleaner.
 NOTE: Allow cleaner to soak 10 minutes to loosen the dirt. Do not let cleaner dry on the pre-cleaner.
- 3. Rinse off pre-cleaner with cool low-pressure water. Continue to rinse until all traces of cleaner are gone. If it is extremely dirty it may be necessary to repeat steps 1 and 2. If there are spots of dirt remaining , spray each spot directly with cleaner, allow a few minutes for it to soak and repeat rinsing step.
- 4. After rinsing, gently shake off excess water and allow to dry naturally. Do not proceed to the oiling step until it is completely dry.

CAUTION: THE USE OF ANY OTHER DRYING METHODS (I.E. COMPRESSED AIR, DRYER HEATERS, HEAT GUNS) COULD DAMAGE FILTER.

- 5. Apply K&N air filter oil liberally to the pre-cleaner.
 - A. If using a K&N squeeze bottle, squeeze bead of oil along the crown of each pleat using the lip on the squeeze bottle tip as a guide. Utilize graduated view strip on bottle to dispense proper amount of oil.
 - B. If using a K&N aerosol spray, spray an even amount of oil along the crown of each pleat.
 NOTE: Wait 20 minutes for the oil to be absorbed into the pre-cleaner.
