

Billet Lower Engine Mount

For: 2010+ Fusion Sport 3.5L

Installation Instructions for part: 555-4028

Refer to a shop manual for torque specifications.

Removal of the factory engine mount


- **1.** Lift the front of the car so that the front wheels are off the ground. Use caution operating a lift, or jack stands, to ensure the car is stable, and safe, to work around, and underneath.
- 2. Remove the two nuts from the exhaust pipe at the flex pipe flange to allow the exhaust/powertrain to move around easily while the mount is being replaced.
- **3.** Remove the two bolts attaching the front mount bracket to the transmission case. See figure 1.
- **4.** Loosen the rear engine mount bolt at the subframe a few turns and pull the front of the mount (with bracket still attached) down to remove the bolt attaching the bracket to the mount. See figure 2.
- Remove the rear engine mount bolt, at the subframe mount, after gently rocking the engine enough to carefully wedge a small 2x4 block between the floor pan and exhaust pipe to gain clearance for the bolt.


Installation of the Steeda Billet Lower Engine Mount

- **6.** Generously grease the faces of all the bushings in the billet engine mount.
- **7.** Place the Steeda mount in the same location and orientation of the factory mount. The end with the larger bushings mount to the subframe. See figure 3.
- **8.** Place the supplied spacer to the left in between the mount and bracket at the transmission mount.
- **9.** Finish installation in reverse of removal, and torque all bolts to specification.
- **10.**Road test the vehicle. Any clunking or unusual noises should not be present. If so, re-check installation and torque on all fasteners.
