

STEEDA Front Swaybar Brace

2005 Mustang Installation Instructions for 555-553

Caution! Installing this product requires disassembly of some components of the suspension. If you are not confident you can complete the job safely, have the work performed by a certified technician who is familiar with the front suspension of a Mustang. Failure to reassemble the suspension properly can lead to serious injury.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:

- Carefully raise the vehicle to access the front suspension. If working from the floor, be sure to secure the vehicle on jack stands.
- (Pic 1) Locate the nuts that attach the K-member (or number 2 cross member) to the vehicle. Be sure to properly support the weight of the K-member prior to removing the nuts.
- 3. (Pic 2) Remove the front two K-member nuts
- **4.** (Pic 3) Remove the top left and top right nuts connecting the sway bar mounts to the number 1 cross member.
- **5. (Pic 4)** Be sure to use the provided spacer on the sway bar side as shown
- 6. (Pic 5) Note that the braces are specific to each side of the vehicle. Install both the left and right braces by sliding the hole in the straight tab onto the K-member bolt after positioning the hole in the angled tab over the top swaybar bracket bolt on the number one cross member. Replace both the K-member nuts and the sway bar nuts. Tighten to factory specifications.
- **7.** Double-check all connections. Then, carefully remove the support from the K-member and lower the vehicle.
- 8. Test drive and enjoy!
